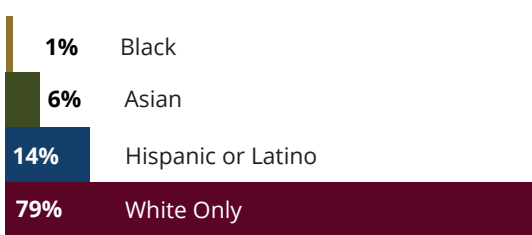

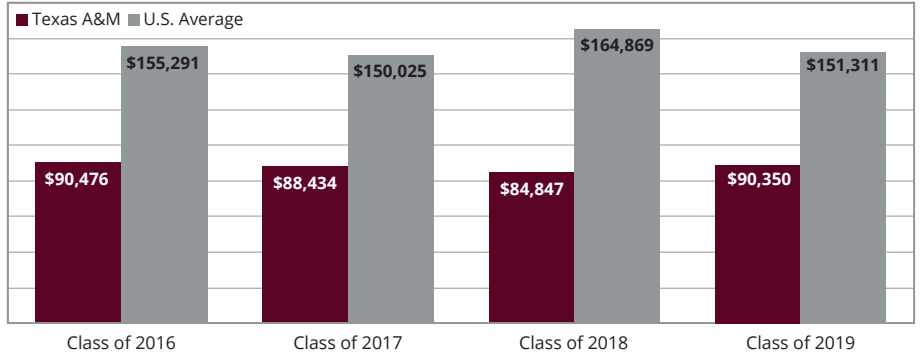

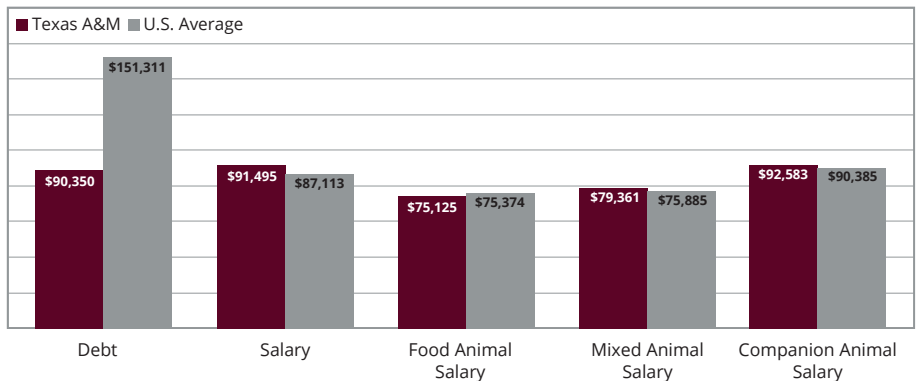

Mean DVM Student Total Educational Debt at Graduation Over Time

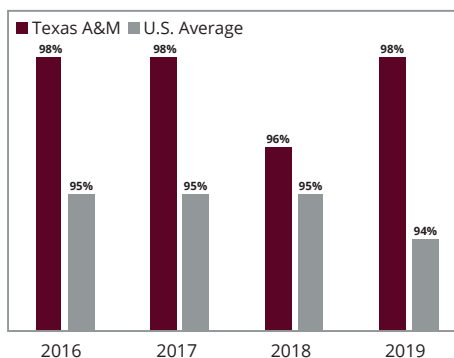


Mean DVM Student Debt, Salary & Track Salary for the Graduating Class of 2019

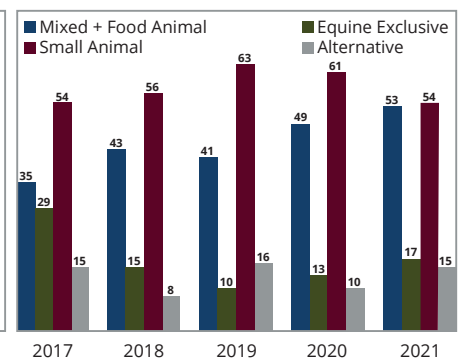

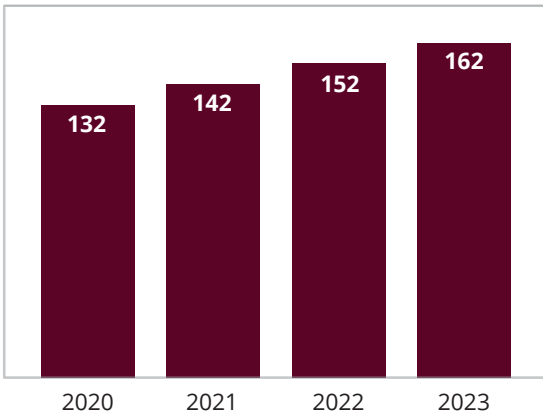
NAVLE Pass Rate Over Time



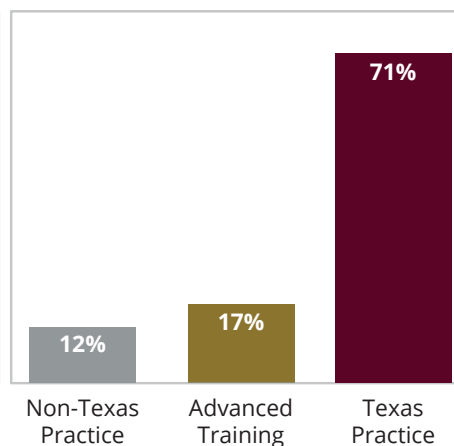
DVM Track Choices Over Time



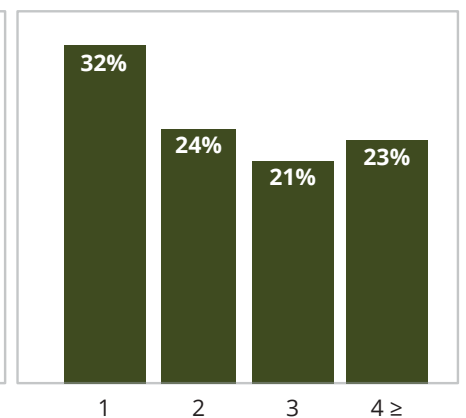
DVM Class Size Over Time

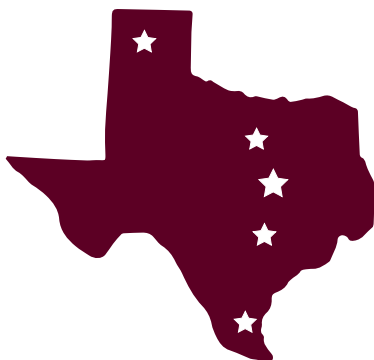

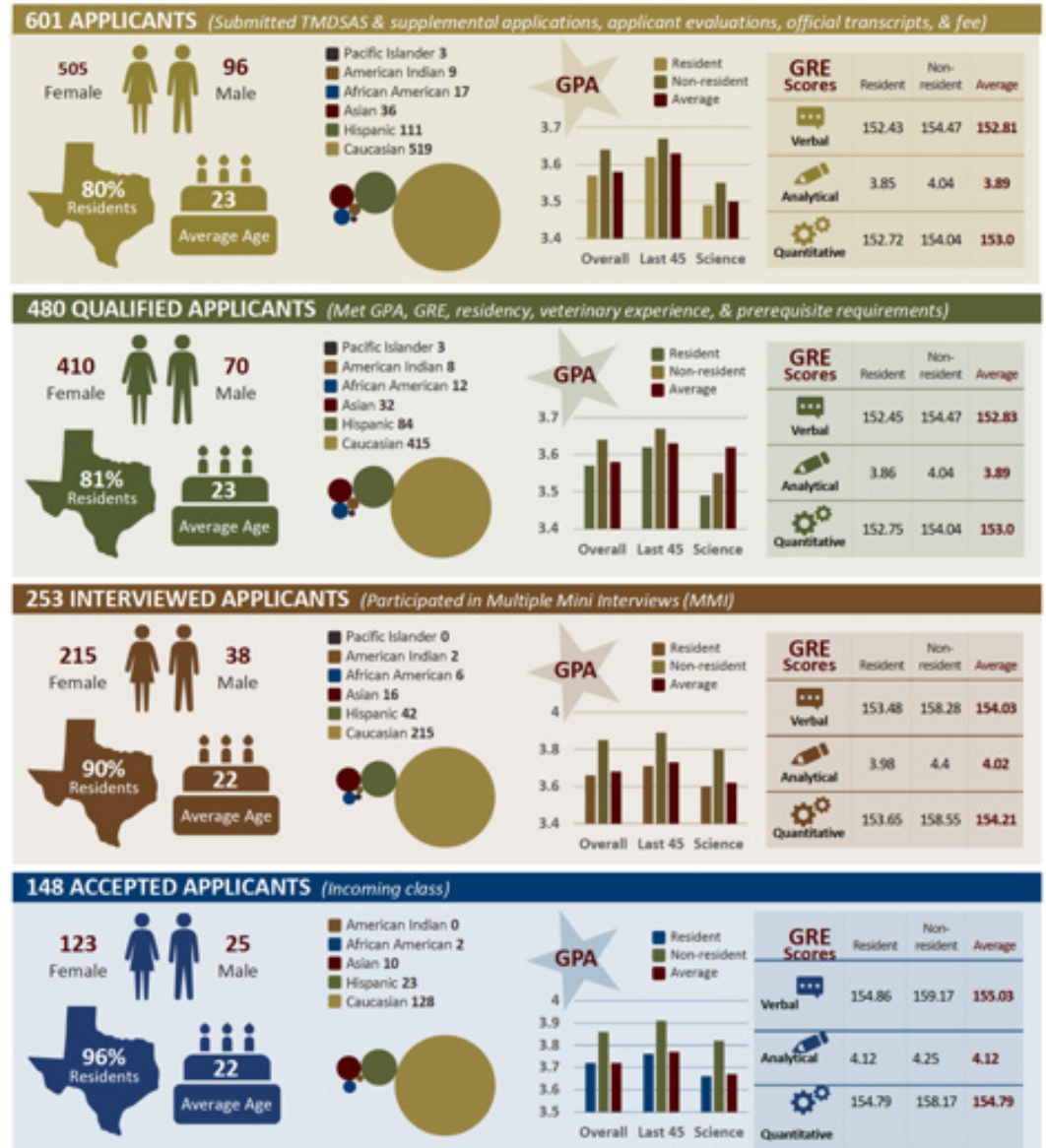

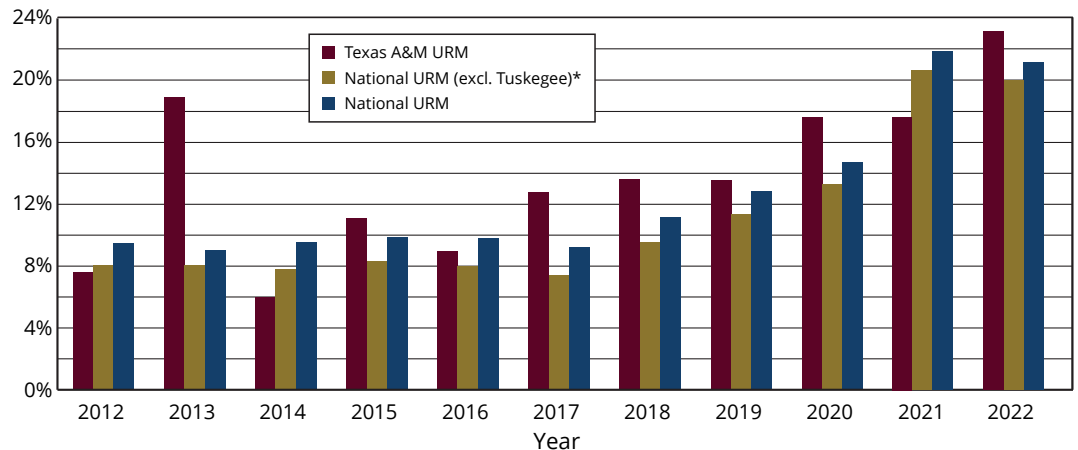
